

PUBLIC NOTICE
TOWN OF CENTURY HOUSING PRESERVATION GRANT PROGRAM
APPLICATIONS FOR HOUSING ASSISTANCE

The Town of Century will begin accepting applications to assist in the rehabilitation of fifteen (15) very-low and low-income owner occupied housing units **beginning Monday, December 1, 2014**, under the Housing Preservation Grant Program. Funds for this program are provided through USDA, Rural Development, Housing Services. Applications will be processed on a first-come, first-serve basis. Only those residents meeting the following criteria will be eligible for assistance: (1) All applicants must reside within the municipal boundaries of the Town of Century; (2) The dwelling unit must be a single-family detached housing unit—mobile homes are not eligible under this Program; (3) The applicant must have fee simple title to the property (name must be on the deed to the property); (4) The applicant must meet the income limits, which are based on family size; and, (5) Rehabilitation activities must contribute to the health, safety and well being of the homeowner and fall within the range of \$2,000 to \$5,000, the level of funding assistance available for each unit.

The Town will set up and maintain a housing assistance waiting list for this Program. To apply, please call Century Town Hall at (850) 256-3208, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. beginning on December 1, 2014. Note that your name will **not** be placed on the waiting list if you call before Monday, December 1, 2014.
